## VILLAGE OF SHELL LAKE

The rains have certainly caused grief for many residents this year. Council is scratching it's head as to how to rectify some of the issues but it is the same old story.....you can't fix a leaking roof when it's raining and when it isn't raining you don't need to.

We were able to utilize the asphalt crew that was in the village to cap some sidewalks. It looks good but we

will have to see how it lasts. It was less work and less costly than doing cement.

A huge thank you to the volunteers that answered the request to mow grass at cemetery on June 20th. Great job!

Now I will give you some facts on the operation of the Shell Lake cemetery. The RM of Spiritwood has assigned the caretaking of the cemetery to the Village of Shell Lake. About five years ago they withdrew any funding towards the cemetery so any expenses are now paid for by the cemetery committee. The Village contributes by paying for the gas, maintenance person wages and provides some equipment. We have an appointed committee which consists of Christine Wollms, Donna Prafke, Jim Mayo. The veteran's plot is maintained by the Legion. To keep the cemetery in respectable condition it requires mowing every three weeks and it is too much work for the maintenance person or the committee to do it all so that is why we have been calling for volunteers. The good news is that we may have a solution! The PA penitentiary provides a service whereby they come out with 2 zero turn mowers, 2 push mowers, 2 whipper snippers and 6 men and do the job. The cost??? to provide lunch to the workers! So

we are set to give it a whirl on July 5th. If it rains they will choose an alternate day. I for one am excited!

The construction at curling rink is progressing with most of the drywalling being completed. The well has been drilled. Next up will be more electrical, cement pouring and all the refrigeration installation.

July is the month we celebrate our village with the annual HeyDays. I know it involves a lot of work and involves everybody but it is always worth the effort. So Happy HeyDays everyone!
