The veteran's plot is maintained by the Legion. To keep the cemetery in respectable condition it requires mowing every three weeks and it is too much work for the maintenance person or the committee to do it all so that is why we have been calling for volunteers. The good news is that we may have a solution! The PA penitentiary provides a service whereby they come out with 2 zero turn mowers, 2 push mowers, 2 whipper snippers and 6 men and do the job. The cost??? to provide lunch to the workers! So

we are set to give it a whirl on July 5th.If it rains they will choose an alternate day. I for one am excited!

The construction at curling rink is progressing with most of the drywalling being completed. The well has been drilled. Next up will be more electrical, cement pouring and all the refrigeration installation.
