The Curling Rink is getting near to

exterior doors to the temporary serv-
ice. The interior flooring was installed

Council Highlights:

- Board and Committee appoint-
ments were done at the December
council meeting. A few were tabled
until the new year. I will post in the
Hi-Lites when complete. HUGE
THANKS to all our volunteers that
give their time as committee mem-
bers!! Greatly Appreciated!!

- Council has approved the new
website project for the Village. A
website designer has been hired to
develop and implement a new site
that will help keep our residents in-
formed of Village happenings.

- The annual acknowledgements
of the Council's public disclosure
statements were recognized. This
acknowledgement along with vari-
ous other financial disclosures are
required to be submitted annually
to the provincial government to
ensure the Village receives a munici-
pal revenue sharing grant from the
province. This grant is based upon
the population, and provides pre-
dictable, no-strings-attached fund-
ing that is based on three-quarters

of one point of PST revenue from
two years prior.

- Discussion in regards to sewer
line installations and hookups has
resulted in new procedure for 2025.
This will include additional informa-
tion being required, including a
sketch of the sewer installation. This
will form part of the building and de-
velopment permit process.
