- Council has approved the new website project for the Village. A website designer has been hired to develop and implement a new site that will help keep our residents informed of Village happenings.
- The annual acknowledgements of the Council's public disclosure statements were recognized. This acknowledgement along with various other financial disclosures are required to be submitted annually to the provincial government to ensure the Village receives a municipal revenue sharing grant from the province. This grant is based upon the population, and provides predictable, no-strings-attached funding that is based on three-quarters

of one point of PST revenue from two years prior.

- Discussion in regards to sewer line installations and hookups has resulted in new procedure for 2025. This will include additional information being required, including a sketch of the sewer installation. This will form part of the building and development permit process.
