VILLAGE OF SHELL LAKE BYLAW 10 – 2010

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF SHELL LAKE TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 9/87 KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW

The Council of the Village of Shell Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 9/87 as follows:

- 1. The Zoning Districts referred to in Section 5 Subsection 5.5 forming part of Bylaw No. 9/87 is amended as follows:
 - 5.5 Fence
 - 5.5.1 Fence at the front of the lot be no more than one (1) metre in height.
 - 5.5.2 Fence at the sides and back to be no more than two (2) metres in height.
 - 5.5.3 On corner lots, the front fence is to be no more than one metre in height. Flank age on the side street, up to twenty-five feet from the front street corner, to be no more than one metre in height.
 - 5.5.4 Where fencing is proposed in any residential or commercial district, such fencing shall be of decorative nature. Decorative fence material may consist of wrought iron, faux wrought iron, brick, stone, board or chain-link fence. Barbwire is prohibited in any residential district.
 - 5.5.5 Determination of an acceptable fence material shall be at the discretion by the Council.
 - 5.5.6 Building Permit is required, but at no charge.
 - 5.5.7 Bylaw no. 4-98 is hereby repealed.
 - 5.5.8 This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing thereof.
