postponed due to weather. We will
look at rescheduling for next spring.
Thank you to everyone that took
the initiative and picked up garbage

in the Village. - Fire Ban
was implemented on April 25, 2025
and was removed on June 26, 2025.
That was a long wait!! Caution is still
needed in using your outdoor fire
pit. Our community does not have
fire hydrants or pressurized water
lines to fight a large fire. -
Tree trimming will be taking place in
the near future. Many alleyways are
growing in and power lines are be-
ing covered by the trees which poses
a fire risk. If you have an area that
you are concerned about, please
contact Tara at the Village Office and
notify Sask Power.

Also, when planting trees be
aware of where the power lines are
running. Those baby trees do be-
come a problem when they get big
and are under the lines.

- Reminder that Golf Carts are not
allowed down main street. You can
cross over main street and then con-
tinue on. Please follow the rules.
Let's ensure we do not lose this privi-
lege!

- Walking Trails on the east side of
the Village are in the process of be-
ing groomed. Check them out. Beau-
