Village Snow Removal Policy 145-15

- 1) Please have vehicles moved out of the way for clearing streets between 7a.m. and 9 a.m.
- 2) Village is not responsible for clearing snow from driveways
- 3) Village requests that you be considerate with where your snow is going when you are clearing your property. Do not push snow from your driveway across the road to the other side of the street, it can be dangerous for grader when plowing the streets.
- 4) As streets are graded, a snow ridge is often left across driveways leaving them inaccessible for a short

period of time. Once all streets within the Village have been cleared of snow, the Village will make every effort to clear ridges from driveways.
