****BUSINESS LICENCES** -
\$100.each/year. \$25.00/ one time
project. This fee is required by all
trades that are performing work in the
Village! It is not fair to charge our
local businesses and not collect from
visiting trades. Thanks for letting the
Village Office know if you see an
unfamiliar service vehicle in the
Village.

**** GARBAGE PICKUP** – Limit is 3
bags and not more than 30 lbs. All
grass clippings, etc. must be in a
compostable bag. All Large Garbage
Bin Fees of \$20.00/truckload are due
within one week of drop off. The

usage is partially based on an honor
system when the gate is open and
staff are not advised of your deliv-
ery. We thank you for helping us
cover a small portion of the bin cost
when you pay the fee. The Big Item
Gargage bin will be available for one
more week.

****All DOG and CAT licenses of
\$10.00/ pet are past due for 2025.**

**As our winter weather approaches
just a friendly reminder:**

Village Snow Removal Policy 145-15

1) Please have vehicles moved out
of the way for clearing streets be-
tween 7a.m. and 9 a.m.

2) Village is not responsible for clear-
ing snow from driveways

3) Village requests that you be
considerate with where your snow is
going when you are clearing your
property. Do not push snow from
your driveway across the road to the
other side of the street, it can be
dangerous for grader when plowing
the streets.

4) As streets are graded, a snow
ridge is often left across driveways
leaving them inaccessible for a short

period of time. Once all streets within
the Village have been cleared of
snow, the Village will make every
effort to clear ridges from driveways.

of God’s Word. This principle remains

church today! May God forever re-
form our church, communities, hearts,
and minds.
